G. SEDIMENT CONTROL

- 1) I/We agree to adhere to the terms of the Standard Erosion and Sediment Control Plan for Forest Harvest Operations, and to other attached plans/documents per this approval. I/We grant official state and county representatives including Maryland DNR Forest Service staff the right of entry to the site to monitor compliance and effect enforcement, as applicable. Contact Maryland DNR Forest Service at (410) 535-1303 at least 3 business days prior to mobilizing any harvesting equipment.
- 2) I/We are aware of the landowner’s responsibility to prevent accelerated erosion and sedimentation during and subsequent to forest harvest operations as mandated by the rules and regulations adopted by the State of Maryland and local jurisdictions, and the *2015 Maryland Soil Erosion and Sediment Control Standards and Specifications for Forest Harvest Operations or as revised/updated*.
- 3) I/We agree to require that all operators conducting forest harvest operations on the above-named operation shall adhere to the requirements of the Standard Plan and any amendments to the plan.
- 4) I/We agree to notify the local office of the Maryland Forest Service within 48 hours before beginning the harvest operations and 48 hours before completing harvest operations.
- 5) This plan shall expire in 3 years or as noted in the approval.
